



RESIDENTIAL SAFE ROOM GRANT PROGRAM



The Residential Safe Room Grant Program, established by the **Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (MEMA)** with funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation grants, offers Mississippi residents reimbursement for installing a properly designed safe room or storm shelter on their property.

APPLICATION PERIOD OPEN STARTING FEBRUARY 10TH, 2025 TO MARCH 10TH, 2025

Who Qualifies for Assistance?

MEMA's Residential Safe Room Grant Program will be offered to individuals in the **33** counties impacted by severe storms, tornadoes, straight-line winds, and flooding in February 2019 and July 2020.

Eligible counties include **Alcorn, Amite, Calhoun, Carroll, Chickasaw, Claiborne, Coahoma, Covington, George, Grenada, Itawamba, Jefferson Davis, Jones, Lafayette, Lawrence, Lee, Leflore, Montgomery, Panola, Pike, Pontotoc, Prentiss, Quitman, Simpson, Smith, Sunflower, Tallahatchie, Tishomingo, Union, Washington, Wayne, Webster, Yalobusha**. Only applicants from the counties listed are eligible to apply.

* Safe rooms purchased and/or installed before receiving an official "Approval Letter" from MEMA's Residential Safe Room Grant Program are NOT ELIGIBLE for reimbursement.
